Venice Art Center Call To Artists: Sea Venice

The Venice Art center invites you to submit an application and proposal outlining your ideas and designs for the 2012-2014 “Sea Venice” project. [The deadline for submissions is May 15, 2012](#)

Project overview: “Sea Venice” is a public arts project with all proceeds going to the Venice Art Center to support our programs and to promote the arts and tourism for the community of Venice, FL. Local artists, in partnership with “Sea Venice” sponsors, will create unique designs for 20 fiberglass dolphins and 20 fiberglass sea turtles. These statues will be adorned by the most talented artists in our region. We will match sponsors to artists and a plaque will be placed at the base of each sculpture to indicate the name of the sponsor, the artist and the animal’s individual name. The statues will appear in approved locations in Venice on city streets, parks, lobbies, businesses, etc. There will also be multiple public activities, fundraisers and entertainment events associated with this project.

Call to Artists: The Sea Venice artist committee will choose artists through a juried process based on the proposals submitted. All designs must be approved by this committee. Designs must be artistic and creative. All additions and embellishments to the statue need to be pre-approved by the committee. No company logos or political statements will be allowed on any sculptures. Any design considered inappropriate or tasteless by our judges will not be approved. All animal sculptures are the property of the Venice Art Center and the Venice Art center will have all rights to reproduction and image. Artists will be paid \$600 to paint or otherwise embellish one fiberglass animal. Artists are responsible for the purchasing the materials and supplies to decorate the animal sculpture. Artist names will be printed on the plaque at the base of the sculpture.

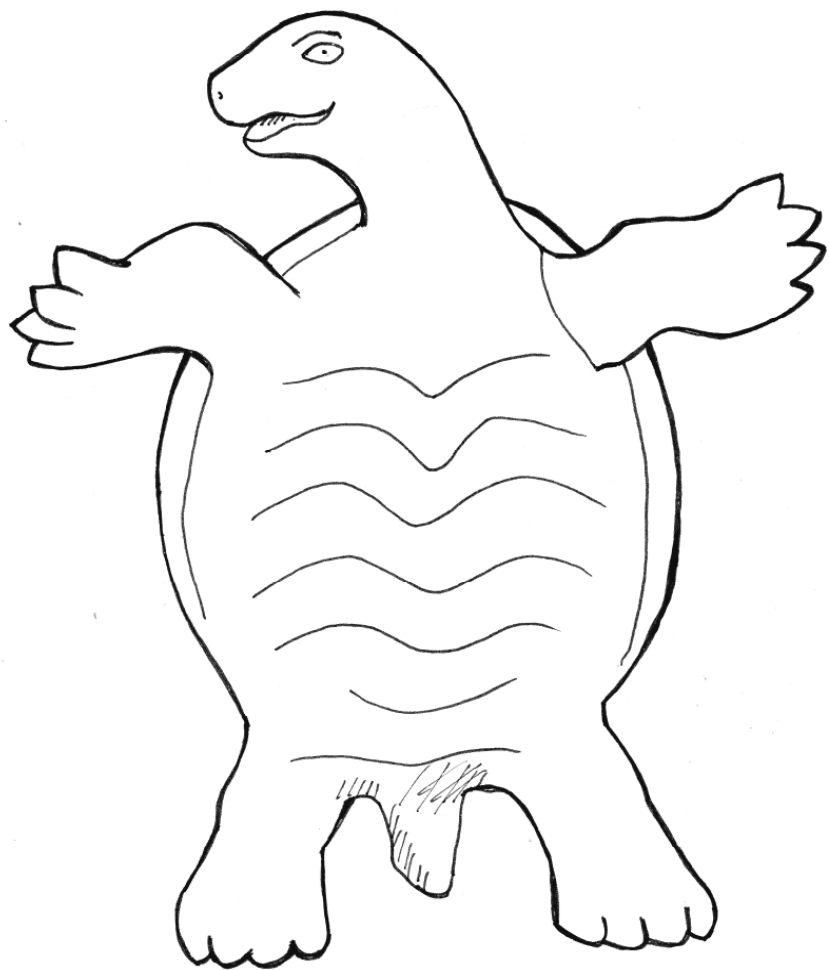

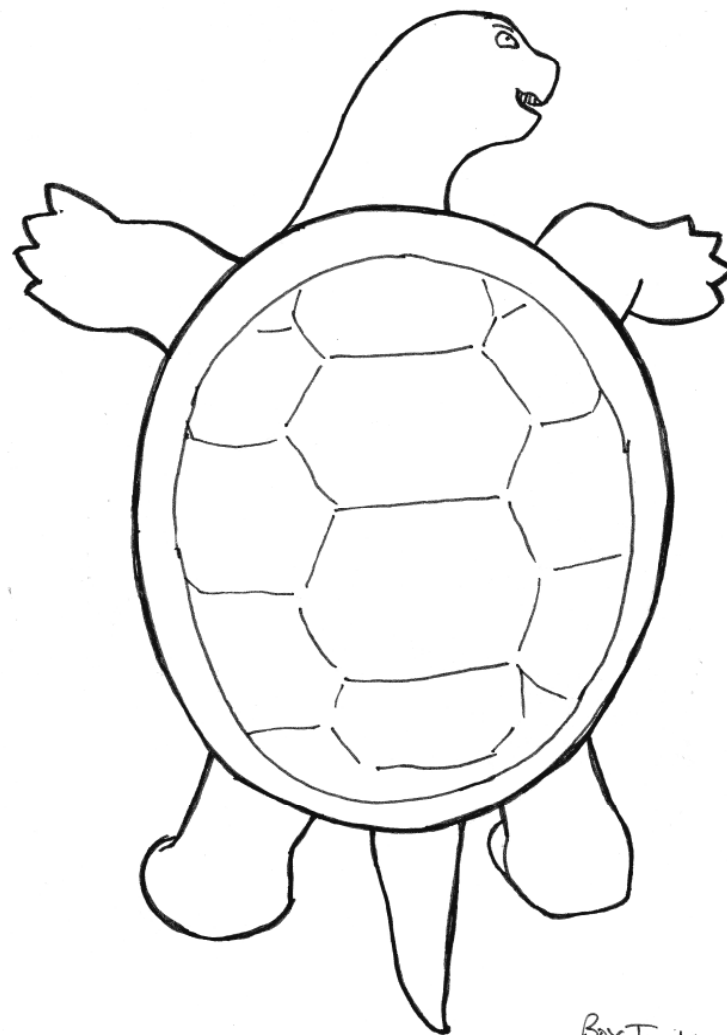

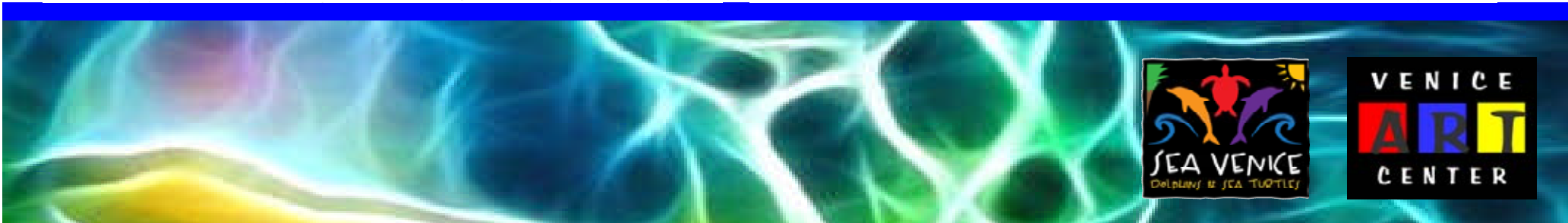
