June 18th Comic Relief Karen Hitt 10 & Up

Bring in your favorite animated characters. We will learn how to create our own "story book" and bring your character to life in "Comic Relief".

June 25th Batik Painting Amy Webber 9 & Up

Painting with dyes and wax on fabric. You will also learn tie dying and fabric printing. Bring your wild ideas and a couple of white t-shirts. Fabric and art supplies provided.

This is a very simple process with amazing results. Bring dark colored T-shirts or other dark colored Fabric items you might want to use (Examples: pillow cases, totes, etc.)

July 23rd Going Green: Trash to Treasure Mikayla Saepoff 5 - 8

Clean out those drawers and bring in your small found objects. We will create a treasure boxes as well as other creations from recycled items. We will learn about going green and the skies the limit to what you can do!

Water will be our key ingredient. Watch your paintings come to life as we learn to paint with watercolors.

How it works: Each class meets twice a week (either Mon/Wed or Tue/Thur) for two weeks– for a total of four 2 hour classes, held from either 10am-12noon or 1pm-3pm, unless otherwise noted.

Cost: \$70 for members and \$75 for non-members per session, with the exception of glasswork and photography. Those prices are noted in the description. Mix It Up Fridays cost \$40 for members and \$45 for non-members. Kid's Night Out costs \$30 for members or \$35 for non-members. The workshop rates are (ages 7-8) \$100 for members and \$110 for non-members and ages 9 and up \$175 for members, \$185 for non-members. All supplies are included, unless noted in the description of the class.

Please read carefully: Upon receipt of your registration form and payment in full, you are registered. FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. If a class of your choice is cancelled (due to lack of enrollment), you will be notified. In that case, you are entitled to a full refund. No written confirmation will be sent to you.
