How it works: Each class meets twice a week for two weeks (either Mon/Wed or Tue/Thurs); for a total of four 2-hour classes, held from either 10am-12noon or 1pm-3pm, unless otherwise noted.

Please read carefully: Upon receipt of your registration form and payment in full, you are registered. **FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.** If a class of your choice is cancelled (due to lack of enrollment), you will be notified. In that case, you are entitled to a full refund. No written confirmation will be sent to you. If you do not receive a phone call, your child has been enrolled in the class of your choice.

Our classes are designed to foster creativity and imagination in a friendly, safe environment. They are structured to give children the confidence they need to develop and complete projects. Our teachers are professional art educators dedicated to helping children acquire skills they can use throughout their lives. Children should wear appropriate clothing for art and craft activity. Special needs children must be accompanied by a caregiver.
