

Photo Editing on the iPad – Supply List

This is a six-hour course, spread over two half days

- **iPad** - model 2 or later; apps won't work on original iPad 1
- **Stylus** – no need to buy an expensive one; some of my favorites were free giveaways!
- **Charger** - Just in case: you don't want to run out of battery life in the middle of the workshop.

At least a week before the workshop, download two apps:

- **Snapseed**
- **Adobe Photoshop Mix**

Once you have downloaded them, open them immediately to make sure they are working. Photoshop Mix will not work until you input an Adobe ID. If you don't have one, just follow the onscreen instructions to create one.

If you already have these apps, make sure that you have the latest versions.

If you need to update them (or aren't sure), go to the App Store. Click on Updates at the bottom of your screen. Look through the list of available updates, and if there is one for either of the apps, click Update. (Don't wait until the last minute to do this. There may not be internet access at the Art Center).

Occasionally, apps are taken off the market or I find new ones that are even better. If that happens, I will let you know ahead of time.

You will need to have a few photos stored on your iPad's Camera Roll. Look for a couple of landscapes and a few people/animals/other items to place in the landscapes. *We may not have internet connection, so don't assume that you will be able to access the Cloud.*

Update your iPad to the latest version

To do this, go to Settings/General/Software Update

(Don't wait until the last minute to do this either; it can take a while to load).

Make sure your iPad is fully charged when you come to class.

Make sure YOU are fully charged when you come to class – get a good night's sleep! 😊
